

ANNOUNCEMENT

The UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed) marking is a new UK product marking that is used for goods being placed on the market in Great Britain (England, Wales and Scotland). It covers most goods which previously required the CE marking, known as 'new approach' goods. For 'Ex' products (formerly ATEX) only 'UKCA Bodies' (the UK equivalent of an ATEX Notified body) will be able to issue the appropriate certificates needed for entry to the UK market and the Standards used will be determined by the UK List of approved Standard (BS). The UKCA marking came into effect on 1 January 2021. However, to allow businesses time to adjust to the new requirements, you will still be able to use the CE marking until 1st January 2023 in most cases.

ABLE Instruments & Controls Ltd is working closely with its key suppliers to ensure full compliance with the UKCA directive. This involves identifying the appropriate notified bodies and, in some cases, liaising with same to provide technical direction. Furthermore, monthly progress reviews with our major Principal companies are carried out to confirm that they are on track to meet the UK government's deadline in this regard.

We would like to assure our customers that, from the 1st January 2023, all products promoted and supplied by ABLE will carry full UKCA approval.
